



## Your AANPCB Wallet Card

The watermarked **Wallet Card** provided below represents your status as a Nurse Practitioner certified by the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners National Certification Board, Inc.

- Your online wallet card is available at no charge and can be accessed by logging into **My AANPCB** at [www.aanpcert.org](http://www.aanpcert.org) and select **My Documents -> Wallet ID Cards**.
- NP certification is time-limited, valid for a period of 5-years, and expires on the certification end date.

It is the NP's responsibility to renew certification before it expires. You may begin the recertification application process 1 year in advance of the expiration date printed on your card. We recommend that you keep your contact information current, be familiar with the recertification requirements, and apply to recertify at least 3 months prior to the expiration date to avoid lapse or loss of certification.
