

## Your AANPCB Wallet Card

The watermarked **Wallet Card** provided below represents your status as a Nurse Practitioner certified by the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners National Certification Board, Inc.

- Your online wallet card is available at no charge and can be accessed by logging into My AANPCB at <u>www.aanpcert.org</u> and select My Documents -> Wallet ID Cards.
- NP certification is time-limited, valid for a period of 5-years, and expires on the certification end date.

It is the NP's responsibility to renew certification before it expires. You may begin the recertification application process 1 year in advance of the expiration date printed on your card. We recommend that you keep your contact information current, be familiar with the recertification requirements, and apply to recertify <u>at least</u> 3 months prior to the expiration date to avoid lapse or loss of certification.
